




Undertaking a degree programme can be a financial burden, especially for self-funding students. That is why MLA College provides the opportunity to spread the cost via a flexible payment plan.


Tuition fees are required to be paid no later than four weeks prior to starting the programme. This date may change nearer the time should spaces on a programme permit late enrolments.

How It Works

Students who need more flexibility with their payments can opt in for the flexible payment plan. Interested students must inform the Student Finance Team of their desire to spread the payments during the enrolment stage prior to starting the programme.

Student Loans

Students from the UK, and some from the EU/EEA who normally reside in England and Northern Ireland, can apply to the Student Loans Company to help fund their studies.

Maritime Operations



This degree programme is designed for those that already have the skills and knowledge in their chosen pathway and do not need to learn the theory behind maritime operations. Using this theory you will be able to use your expertise to undertake an independent 12 month research project.

Programme Overview

Through a comprehensive independent study, you will choose a project relevant to you and/or your workplace. Using a variety of research methodologies and techniques you will explore your topic and identify, analyse and propose solutions to operational challenges faced in the maritime industry, from a business perspective.

Upon successful completion you will be awarded the full MBA qualification.
